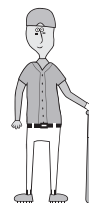

We lined up against the backstop and waited while the two captains selected their teams. One by one we were picked until there was only one left - me. Finally, I became a member by default of the last side to choose.

I felt rejected and unwanted. I understood why I was the last one to be picked: I was older, probably the slowest, certainly the fattest. But even so, in my own mind at least, I was good. Once the game got underway, my sense of rejection disappeared; but later that evening it returned, and I felt guilty because it had. It seemed so petty.

But the hurt disappeared when I remember that God had chosen me, not at the end of the game, but at the very beginning - even before the beginning. In God's infinite mercy, I am chosen to be on God's side. God loves me. I am not rejected. In God, I am chosen. Ephesians 1:4.
