SIGNERS OF THE DECLARATION OF INDEPENDENCE



Signer #18: Lewis Morris (1726-1798)

New York. Age at signing: 50

Married: Mary (10 children)

Occupation: Landowner

Quotes & Notes:

Lewis was born on April 8, 1726, at Morrisania, the eldest of three sons. His father personally managed his early education, teaching him at home until he entered Yale College at the age of sixteen, where "under the care of the learned and pious Dr. Camp, he was taught the learned languages and mathematics; and his youthful mind was infused with the lessons of morality and religion."

Later Morrisania, as could have been expected, was under British control. Knowing it belonged to one of the signers, the British wasted no time in plundering and destroying everything.

His fine woodland of more than a thousand acres, all upon navigable water, and within a few miles of the capital - of a value not easily measured, but evidently worth an immense price - was totally laid bare and given up to plunder and conflagration. His house, from which his family were obliged to retreat, was spoiled and injured; his fences burnt or prostrated; his stock driven off; his domestics and tenants dispersed; and his whole estate was laid waste and ruined, as much as was within the power and opportunity of the British forces.
