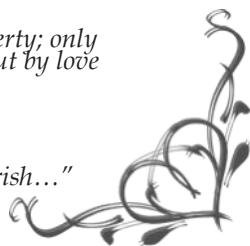
Theme for 2017 - *Love*

Defending the Flag

During the Vietnam War era, Bill Pierson, a husky football star stood alone for three hours, defending the US flag from 150 campus protestors intent on lowering the flag to half-staff in support of their defiant cause.

After the incident, Pierson received hundreds of telephone calls, letters, and telegrams commending him for his heroic stand.

The 6-foot-3-inch, 250-pound defender commented, "I am overwhelmed! I was born under that flag. I fought for that flag and what it stands for. I wouldn't have moved if they had moved!"

In giving him a "Citation for Meritorious Service," the American Legion said, "This community, yes, this nation, owes Bill Pierson a debt of deep gratitude!"
