A Song in the Night

During the Thirty Years War of the 1600s, German pastor Paul Gerhardt and his family were forced to flee from their home. One night, in a small village inn, homeless and afraid, his wife broke down and cried in despair. To comfort her, Gerhardt reminded her of Scripture promises. Then, going out to the garden alone, he too broke down. He felt this was his darkest hour.

Soon afterward, Gerhardt felt the burden lifted and sensed anew the Lord's presence. Taking his pen, he wrote this hymn:

"Give to the winds thy fears;
 Hope, and be undismayed;
 God hears thy sighs and counts thy tears;
 God shall lift up thy head.
 Through waves and clouds and storms
 He gently clears the way.
 Wait thou His time, so shall the night
 Soon end in joyous day."

It is often in our darkest times that God makes His presence known most clearly. He uses our sufferings and troubles to show us that He is our only source of strength. And when we see this truth, like Pastor Gerhardt, we receive new hope.

Are you facing a great trial? Take heart. Put yourself in God's hands. Wait for His timing. He will give you a "song in the night" (Psalm 77:6).
