### Some History of Disarmament

**1929** – The Soviet Union enforced gun control

**Result:** 1929-1953 – 20 million dissidents were killed

**1935** - Germany disarmed its citizens

**Result:** 1939-1945 15 million Jews & gentiles were killed by the Nazis

**1935** – China disarmed its citizens

**Result:** 1948-1952 – 20 million citizens were killed as political dissidents

**1956** – Cambodia enforced gun control

**Result:** 1975-1977 - 1 million citizens were killed by their government

**1970** – Uganda enacts gun control

**Result:** 1971-1979 – 300,000 Christians were killed
