What is the Book of Numbers about?

The name of the book of Numbers comes from the two **numberings** or **countings** of the people in chapters 1:19 and 26:4. The book gives the history of the Israelites from the point at which Exodus ended, when they were in the **wilderness of Sinai** in the second month of the second year after the departure from Egypt, to the **end** of the wilderness wanderings in the tenth month of the fortieth year, when they were in the plains of Moab, facing the land of Canaan.

Very little is said about the **forty years** of wandering in the wilderness, for it was a time of failure. If the children of Israel had had more faith and had entered the land **when God meant them to do so**, they would have been in Canaan within **less than two years** after they left Egypt (see Deuteronomy 1:2; 2:14).

Because they would not trust God, even after all He had done for them, they needed to be **punished** by the thirty-nine years of waiting, until all the unbelievers had died, and a **new generation** was ready to enter the land.
