What is the Book of Deuteronomy about?

The name Deuteronomy comes from two Greek words, deuteros meaning **second**, and nomos meaning **law**. It is not a second law nor merely a repetition of the Law, but is a **summary of the chief points** of the Law as it affected the people in general, and was given by Moses in three great speeches to the children of Israel, as they were in the plain of Moab just about to enter the **Promised Land**.

Since all those who had come out of Egypt had died in the wilderness because of their disobedience (see Numbers 32), now Moses wished to emphasize to their children the importance of obeying God and the Law which had been given at Sinai (Exodus 19, 20).
