What is the Book of 2 Chronicles about?

Second Chronicles continues the history begun in 1 Chronicles, and covers the same period of the history as the books of the Kings. It begins with the **reign of Solomon**, and continues through the reigns of the **kings of Judah** until the **final captivity**, covering a period of **427 years** (Ussher).

The people of Judah, led by their kings and princes, are pictured as steadily **sinking into apostasy**, with **occasional spiritual revival** under Asa, Jehoshaphat, Joash, Hezekiah, and Josiah. **Humility** is an important theme with **20%** of all references in the Bible contained in this book. The most famous being **7:14**.

Russell Gives Life for Sailor

When the troop-ship *Birkenhead* was lost, a young officer--Alexander Cumine Russell--commanded one of the boats carrying the women and children. He saw a sailor's body swimming above the waves close to the boat.

There was not room for a single person more, but a woman in the boat cried in agony: "Save him! He is my husband!"

Russell looked at the woman and her children and the struggling sailor, then plunged into the water and helped the man to what had been his own place of safety. Then he disappeared from view among the angry waves and the hungry sharks.

He Took the Grenade

Some time ago the Portland *Oregonian* carried the story of the posthumous award of the Medal of Honor to an African-American soldier from the South.

This soldier with several buddies was in a trench during a Vietcong attack when a grenade was thrown into it. Without hesitation, he encircled the grenade with his body and took the full force of the explosion.

His commanding officer, in making the citation, said that his sacrificial and heroic act had saved the lives of the other soldiers in the trench.
