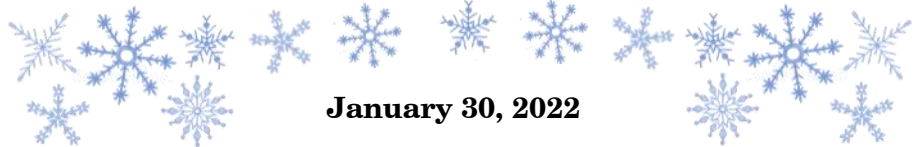

Please sign up if you plan on coming, and include any guests you are bringing.

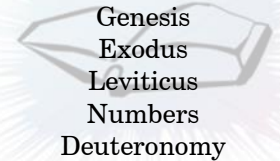

*What is the Book of Mark About?*

The book of Mark portrays Christ as a **servant** to God and man. It is a book of perpetual **action** more than words. The gospel of Matthew has **629** red letter verses, whereas the book of Mark has **281**. This book is written with **Roman and Gentile** Christians in mind, with Hebrew words and customs are often interpreted for the Gentiles to understand. There are many **personal touches** referred to about events, and **Christ's feelings** are often alluded to. Of the specific miracles in Christ's ministry, **19** of the **35** are described in Mark.
