This has been a struggle for me, and I can't wait to drive down the tent stakes in Papua New Guinea so we can work with people again!

What a blessing it was for us to be with a pastor in northern Alabama before Thanksgiving this year! He let us get to know his church and his people. He took me out to go calling before the revival meetings in the evening. That man and the people there have built that work on relationships. Its just a small little town, but they have been gathering in a harvest by going and getting people. Not only that, but caring for them after they are in the church! This little church is doing it right, and God is rewarding them for it.

Some of the places we go have great programs set up, they have great ministries to get involved in, but the church doesn't care for the health of its own people. I think this has led to a lot of our decline in America. Pastors, please remember that those people are the ministry! Sunday school, youth group, round up Sunday, or whatever your church does are tools to help people, not events that need people to survive! Feed your people with the church, don't feed your church with people!

Seeing these churches and the needs of the people in them has helped my prayer life as well! There are so many people needing God's help, and we christians can pray for them and show them the love of God, and His saving grace!
