We are so happy that there is a climate that we can distribute the Bible freely; more freely than in our home country! We are hoping to get over there soon so that we can get busy for the LORD in getting His word to christians and people who need salvation.

One of the reasons we are praying that we can get to Papua New Guinea by September is that the National Independent Baptist Pastors Conference is being hosted in our future back yard. Hundreds of national pastors from all over the country will be coming! We would love to be there for the final preparations and to participate in this important meeting. Pray with us that the pastors are encouraged and strengthened for their service to God and their care of their people.

#### PREPARATIONS FOR PNG:

We are through the first level of approval for our visas! Praise to God for that. We have three more "levels" to get through. We will be trying to handle all of that over the next few months of deputation. Please pray that we have no issues with getting the right documents to where they need to be, and there aren't issues with things getting lost.

There is so much to think about and do, and we are still traveling and visiting churches. We are thankful that God gives us grace and provision as we continue down the road towards Papua New Guinea!

We are always thankful to be able to go out with churches on their visitation programs. Its great for us to be involved in ways that we regularly participated in our home church. It keeps that burden of souls in front of our eyes. It also helps us to get to know the churches that we are with so much better!
