At the last church that we were at, we had a little adventure. There were some pretty severe thunderstorms rolling through the area around dinner time. The girls had already been put to bed, and Kayleigh and I were reading and preparing for the weekend of meetings. The power flickered a bit and the rain picked up. We were parked pretty close to the church building, so we couldn't see much. We could, however, see over it. We looked up and there were many tree branches just floating in the air. After about 10 seconds, they all just started falling. Right after that the power was fine, and the rain died down. It turns out that just on the other side of the church, about 150ft away, there was a tornado!

We were so thankful to God for protecting us. We were close to the church and close to tree lines, so if it had been coming towards us, we wouldn't have very much notice at all! God is so good to us! Protection on the roads we travel, protection from danger like tornadoes! We serve a great God, and I'm glad that we are here to tell the story instead of in the hospital. God is good.

This summer seems to be the year of children's ministry for us. We are scheduled at three different vacation bible schools over the next two months! We are excited any time that we can share missionary stories with kids. They always come up with crazy questions about Papua New Guinea that are fun to answer.
