I am so glad that God has been taking care of us, people have been praying for us, God has been giving us ministry opportunities, and no one has dropped our support. Thanks so much for allowing God to direct us and for staying faithful to prayer and giving. We can't do this without your help.

SUMMER ACTIVITIES

Last prayer letter, I asked you to pray for the VBS's that we would be involved in. Thank you so much for praying about those! Between the three VBS's that we attended, there were about 30 kids that either were counseled by someone, or signified in some way that they had trusted Christ to be their Savior. Each church seemed to have banner years for VBS. There were some good records set, or "firsts" at each event. I loved seeing churches get excited about what God would do with them in their communities! God is still working, and God is still saving people just like he always has.

It was good, and I think the kids got the main points. God wants to use us to get His good news to every being, and He helps us get it there. What a great God!

I appreciate everything that he has been doing for us, and for all the legwork in the visa process. It's very nice to know that he is taking care of it and we can focus on deputation.

We have recently heard that our visas are moving ahead, and that's encouraging. We still don't have them, but it seems like God is starting to move us towards PNG.

Please pray as we continue to present our ministry at churches. We are booking a little at a time as we stay busy, but are also trying to prepare for leaving for PNG when we get our visa approval. Please pray that we would have wisdom in all the logistics of packing, and traveling, and everything involved with that.

Please pray for Chad and Kirsten Wells. There was a fire in the print shop that we will be working in. The equipment seems to be intact, but the room that it was in has to be gutted and remodeled. I don't know if God will put us over there in time to help with that or not, but pray regardless. There was so much being printed and sent out from that little print shop. Papua New Guinea is open to the KJV Bible and the distribution of literature right now.



There is also damage on the house that we will be moving into because of the earthquake from a few months back. Our "To Do" list just keeps growing for when we get over there. This makes us excited more than anything, I think.
