I am so happy to be able to write this prayer letter! We bought our tickets to Papua New Guinea! We are leaving 12:30am on January 16th from Toronto, Canada. We have been waiting so long for this moment. We are so thankful that many churches have given towards our trip. Between that and what we have saved up, we were able to purchase tickets right away. It's a little scary booking tickets less than two weeks from the departure date, but we've been doing homework on what flights to buy since spring of 2018. We also have great input from missionaries who have travelled these waters before.

It's truly amazing how fast our focus can change when things finally come through. We are now fully in packing and sorting mode as we look to make the trek across the world. Thank you for those of you who pray for us and for those of you who have supported us through deputation. I've said many times before that your help is what has sustained us. We wouldn't be here without our brothers and sisters doing their part bringing our plight before a Holy God who delights in reigning in our affairs. Thank you so much!

Last prayer letter, we asked you to pray that our RV and our truck would be sold. Within days of us sending our prayer letter out, the truck was sold. It was truly an answer to prayer. Please continue to pray for the RV to sell. Please pray that we would have wisdom in how to move forward if it doesn't sell.

Thank you to those churches who sent us gifts for Christmas! It was such a blessing. You all covered our Christmas gifting this year. That is especially helpful because of the major purchases we have to make in country immediately, and the purchase of plane tickets. God has supplied some of our desires through you, and that means so much to us. We are truly blessed by your care.

We are very much looking forward to getting set up and acclimated to PNG. There is some nervousness, of course, but we are all very excited for this transition. Please pray for us and our first few months there as the Wells family will be in the US for March and April. We have been talking a lot lately, and they are confident that we will be up to the challenge. Part of the reason for having multiple families on the mission station was so that the work could proceed in one family's absence. We will be putting that to the test in just over a month. God truly has been in our timing and our provision. We have been learning to rest in His strength, and we know that this concept is what must be applied on the field.

As we are packing, we are also saying some of our goodbyes. We have already said goodbye to friends that we probably won't see again till furlough. I know some of you that receive this haven't seen us in a year or two. We remember so many of the people and churches that were a blessing to us on deputation. Most of our attention is directed at our near future and getting to work in PNG, but we still can't help but think of where you will be and how God will have used you by the time we see you again. We are thankful for you all.
