Thank you for all who have been praying for us! It has shown in God's work over the last two months. It has been interesting, to say the least, with the Wells family being in the United States, but in all of it, God has been good to us in so many ways!

The church plant in Kumiane has been going great! We've had some victories in the last few months. At about the 2 month mark, we started having more people show up on Sundays. Because this will be the 3rd attempt at building a church here, the people of Kumiane were a bit skeptical. Who can blame them? It took about two and a half weeks for God to work in some of the new people's hearts. One man, named Felix, is a carpenter in this area, and he is fairly successful in his work. For two services, he would tell me after we finished that God was talking to him. He said he wasn't ready to make a decision yet, and he didn't want to promise that he would. I asked some friends and my church to pray for him. Another church was having a missions conference and asked for specific prayer requests. I gave them Felix's name. The next service after everyone was praying for him, he got saved! It was awesome! To see God work, to see the saints uniting in prayer over a soul, to see him bow his knee and accept Jesus' gift of salvation was incredible. After he came to tell me that he had gotten saved, I told him about all who were praying for him. The astonishment at the thought that people in the USA would ask God to do something for him was all over his face. Thank you for praying for this village. God is working and we are looking forward to see what doors he opens as we go forward!

In March we put on Pastor's Classes for the pastors in our area. I was one of three men who taught and preached. It was a good time, and God allowed everything to go very smoothly. This was an encouragement because this was our first big event without Chad there to help us. God helped the logistic side of it go seamlessly so that Silas, Bro Shell, and I could focus on the spiritual side of things. I was able to teach about 6 hours on the Holy Spirit over the course of 2 days, using some of what my pastor has put into booklet form. It helped many of the pastors. They left armed with plenty Bible verses to help them. This week, we are putting on the Pastor's School for May. Please pray that all of the teaching and preaching would be helpful and encouraging. We want to see strong pastors go back and help their churches so that God's name will be magnified in this area.

We are expecting our 3rd child in November! Kayleigh and I are excited as we look forward to welcoming a new Dye into the world. Please pray for Kayleigh's and the Baby's health. We are in new territory, literally, having a child outside of the USA. God has provided some friends nearby that have had babies here. We are blessed that God would take care of us, and we are looking to him as we go through this time.
