Hello to our friends and supporters!

What a busy time the past two months have been! Thank you to those of you who have prayed for us. It really makes a difference and we couldn't do what we do without the hand of God coming and bearing much of the load.

CHILDREN'S MINISTRIES

We have seen God working in Kumiane! We were having some problems with the people who go to the Catholic Church and the PNG Bible Church. Since coming to Kumiane, we have been trying get involved with the house line and the people there. We have been teaching in the RI class at the primary school. This is an open hour for churches to come in and teach "religion". We usually preach or teach them Bible stories with an emphasis on salvation. The other churches were not coming to teach the kids, so when we showed up, we got them all. This, of course, caused some waves with the other churches. Thankfully the school headmaster appreciates that we come every week and teach faithfully. God gave us favor in his eyes and he was able to straighten out everything for us. As it stands now, we still have most of the kids because the other churches don't want to take the time.

This past week we started Soldiers for Christ (a kids program that Chad Wells developed) in Kumiane on Monday afternoons. We chose to start the program during a school break, as I wanted to ease into it a bit. We knew we ran the risk of low attendance, but we ended up having 33 kids participate! We stand to easily double this attendance over the next few weeks. Please pray for us that we would be able to handle all the kids that come in. We want to be good stewards with what God is asking us to work with.

Pray that these kids would see that God cares about them and wants to save them! There's a great need for outreach with the school-aged children in the area. Showing them that they matter to the God of the universe can go a long way to reaching their souls for Him!

KUMIANE CHURCH PLANT

Please pray for the little church at Kumiane. Last month we started discipleship for the people who have gotten saved. We have been working to translate discipleship material into Tok Pisin so that they can absorb it well. I'm finding that they have some Bible knowledge from the churches they came out of, but much of their doctrine is messed up. Assurance of Salvation is what we are covering now, and it is a huge deal because they were taught they could easily lose their salvation. Pray that we are clear with what we teach them and that they would comprehend what the Bible says.

This past Sunday was a huge encouragement. The men in the church began to open up and talk about some struggles they were having, some questions they had about spiritual stuff, and they opened up and talked with me about their lives. It is a good sign that they are getting comfortable with us. We have had to learn to slow down from American pace to PNG pace and it is starting to yield some results. Sitting and talking with them and showing them some love has helped us gain trust so that we can help them with spiritual things too. God is changing lives here, and we are privileged to be a part of it!
