We have been traveling quite a bit over the past two months. Thank you to the churches that have had us in to report on what we have done in Papua New Guinea. We've been blessed by the responses of the churches that we've been in recently. We have been taken care of as we travel, and we are so happy to be able to share what we care about with you. It's quite humbling to be used by God, and it is amazing being able to share with you what your involvement has accomplished. We've been able to reunite with friends as well, and there is nothing quite as sweet as seeing God use people across our great country!

In the middle of February, We had to fly Madilenne back to Port Moresby in PNG. Because she was born overseas, she had to appear before a consular officer at the US Embassy in Papua New Guinea to be able to process the Consular Report of Birth Abroad. This document goes along with her PNG birth certificate to prove her US citizenship. We also get her full passport at the same time. We need all of these documents to be able to proceed with getting her added to our visa and getting some important paperwork finished up stateside. While spending several days traveling to do an hour's worth of paperwork wasn't fun, it was necessary to speed things along. Thanks to God for a safe trip, and for the success of our meeting in the Embassy.

We were also able to meet up with our ministry partner, Chad Wells, during one of our layovers. It was a blessing to be able to catch up on what has been happening with us, and what has been going on in PNG while we have been in the US.

We have been getting a good idea of what we will end up doing medically for Madilenne in PNG. We had a few options of how to process her blood samples, and we have narrowed it down a bit. Please continue to pray for wisdom as we will be meeting with our Endocrinologist at the end of March and hopefully testing blood to make sure that we are doing things correctly before we return to PNG. Thanks for all those who have reached out and offered help. It's amazing that God has connected us with so many who are able to help in ways that we need. As we have said in the churches that we are reporting to, God keeps opening up doors to make it possible for us to live in PNG with Madi. It is such a confidence boost to see God taking care of what we are unable to.

Please pray for us as we are on the road. We have all taken turns with the cold, but the churches we've been with have been awesome in taking care of us. We will be travelling and reporting/ presenting in new churches till May. We are hoping to be able to return in May or even June, so we haven't booked meetings after May yet. We will reassess as we get closer. Here are three things that need to happen before we can go back.

1: Madilenne's visa needs to be approved. We are almost to the point that we can finish this!

2: We need to test and finalize our plans to care for Madilenne in PNG, and we need to actually make the purchases of medical supplies and equipment.

3: We need to raise our support and the money to purchase the medical supplies. We have had a few churches take us on, and we are looking at presenting at quite a few new ones as we go down the road. We also have received many gifts from many churches and individuals to contribute to our medical costs. Thanks so much! Everything seemed so daunting when we sat down and crunched the numbers, but God has been supplying!

We are honored to be able to serve God, and you enable us to do so.
