Thank you for all who've been praying for our family over the past few months. We've had a good few months, all things considered with COVID-19. We've been up in Buffalo, NY while we are waiting for churches to open back up and enable us to travel again.

We had a number of churches pick us up for support during our travels in February and March, before everything shut down. We've even had a few contact us and take us on during this time, which was a huge blessing and very unexpected. We have also had special offerings come in to help us as we have been making purchases and starting to get things ready to go back to PNG. God has been awesome, and His people have thrown themselves behind us as we move forward. Thank you so much for having a part with us!

On May 3rd, Pastor Kohl ordained Justin. It was

a special service. It was a bit strange having a "socially distanced" ordination service, but many in our church reached out to voice their congratulations and support. It means so much to have a loving and caring sending church who is behind our efforts in PNG.



Since we have been unable to travel, we have used the time to get some of our medical procedures in order. We have successfully run through the test that we will have to do for Madilenne every 3-4 months. Dr. Tarrido and Dr. Czech were instrumental these past few months as we've worked through learning procedures and terminology necessary to run this test and care for Madi in PNG.

It has been quite the learning curve, but we are happy to have gotten the answers we need to be able to be good stewards of our time and money in PNG.

Pray for us as we make plans to ship our medical supplies and some of our personal items to PNG. We are hoping to be in PNG for 3 uninterrupted years before coming back, and there are things that we would like to be able to ship for our long term stay. Among these items are the medical machines and supplies that we need as well. Please pray for wisdom in how to go about this. As of today, PNG isn't allowing certain shipped parcels to come into the country because of their anti COVID-19 measures. We aren't sure what that means for freight, but please pray that we would have a clear path opened by God.

Pray for us as we have some visa work to do before we can go back. Madilenne needs hers to be issued, and Adrienne will need hers renewed to get back into the country. Again, everything seems just a bit more complicated with the state of the world right now.

We will also be trying to book meetings to build support as states start to open back up. We need to build about \$500 more per month in support before we can go back responsibly. If you would like to help and have us in to present, we would be grateful for that chance. Please pray for meetings and support. We had such good success from our last 5 week trip, and we know that God has been taking care of us as we go.

We've had some victories, and we are looking forward to what God is going to do in the coming months!
