Dear Praying Friends,

What a busy time it has been for our family! Thanks to all who prayed for us as we came back to PNG and went through our 2 week covid quarantine. We got out on time and took a few days to prepare to go back to Pangia.

We thank God that our house was not terribly messy when we got back. We were expecting much worse since the house was empty for 18 months, but we were able to walk right in and start to unpack and clean.

Our first few weeks we were trying to get things up and running again. Many things had not been maintained, but we were able to get the station generator and the radio station up and running. We are so glad that the radio is again broadcasting the Gospel every day in our area!

Coming back to our church in Kumiane was especially sweet! We missed our people very much, and they us. We had some great fellowship and time to catch up that was a huge blessing. We even met some new folks who had gotten saved in the past few months. This was so encouraging on both sides. We knew that God didn't leave with us, and our people saw that He could use them as well! This was a great sign of growth for this church to see.

We also battled some sickness. Kayleigh was down for about two weeks with some kind of pneumonia. It was very rough on her, and kinda brough life to a halt in our home. We are happy that she is doing much better. Please pray, though, as she still tires easily and is short of breath sometimes.

Praise God that He provided a vehicle for us! We got a Landcruiser that fit our needs perfectly. I also prayed that God would make the decision obvious to us, and He certainly did. He provided a seller that had sold vehicles to missionaries previously. This helped us to trust he wasn't trying to take advantage, and the other vehicles had been in great shape as well. We look forward to saving up and making this truck trail ready! God certainly can use this to get the gospel farther than we were able to before.

Please pray for the church at Kumiane. We set July 25th as our next baptism service. There are probably about 25 people who have been saved and have yet to partake. Last time baptism was a huge fight due to what is taught in the false religions around us. Some even believe that if you get re baptized (or as we teach, scripturally baptized, because last time you just got wet) then you will literally grow a second head. This fear is wielded to control people. Please pray that the Spirit of God works on hearts to have faith in the Word and not give into fear.

Please pray for us as well as we are still trying to find a way to get Madi's medical tests into country. The last set sat for a week longer than was expected before we got them, and they are not viable anymore. This is something that we MUST nail down, or we cannot stay in this country. We do have some leads on ways to bring them in, but at this point we are still trying to make plans. These tests are over \$350 a piece by the time they make it here, and we are loathe to waste ministry money on attempts that are unlikely to succeed. Please pray for wisdom in this.
