Greetings!

We have been marching along in the work over the past few months, and things are going very well!

We had Zech Kinney visit us from one of our supporting churches in NY! It was a blast having him, and we believe that God was able to use him here, and also help him a bit with some of what he was needing. It's amazing what God does for people who visit PNG. We are pretty remote from the problems of the USA and home, and God tends to use that distance to speak to folks when they come. Zech helped us with our youth camp, passing out thousands of tracts, helping with infrastructure work on our station, and preaching. It was awesome to see God use him while here! If you are looking to take a trip somewhere and you're willing to try and stay at least 30 days somewhere, consider visiting us in PNG! We are set up to house and take care of guests, and it's a blessing to us!

We were able to take Chad Wells' tractor over to the ground at Kumiane to get it level and ready for our foundation wall. It took most of the day, and we found out that it was very wet and close to the water table. After pulling the tractor out of a mudhole, we smoothed what we could and the church dug out some ditches to help the ground to dry. Hopefully it will be stable enough that we can get cement down in the next few months.

Please pray for:

- Construction on the Kumiane Church Building, and our new clinic!
- Pray that the parts for our truck will come in and that we would be able to get that work done. We are still waiting!
- Pray for our safety during the election time and fighting afterwards.

We took a trip to Lae to get a new to us engine for our bus that our team runs 6 days a week for the school, churches, and other logistical helps. Almost 50 people have come to know Jesus in the 6 months that this bus has run directly because of the work it lets us accomplish!

We were also able to get out 10,000 tracts at a local political rally this past week. Our general elections happen once every 5 years, and they are a spectacle. This is probably the most dangerous time we have in PNG, so please pray that we are able to minister and keep the family safe while doing so!

We just started our 2nd semester of Bible College in Pangia. The students are excited, and maybe a little apprehensive because they know what's expected now. That being said, it looks like it will be an edifying year in the school!

We were just informed this week that our home church is sending money for us to build a little clinic on station. This will be a huge blessing as this ministry continues to grow. Please pray that this compassionate ministry would help people to come to Jesus, and that we would be efficient and successful in building this structure over the 2nd half of this year!
