It meant a lot to this family, and it was a great way to show the love of Christ.

Please pray for our first ever Marriage Conference. We will have it this weekend, and we are hoping that the effects will be lasting. To understand how different this relationship is here in PNG because of customs and traditions, you really have to come and see for yourself. We have been praying and fasting so that God will work in ways that preaching and teaching alone can't.
