We had an amazing year in Papua New Guinea this past year. We had around 20 baptized, and we had many saved. One of those people saved was Juliette, and we are so thankful that she responded to conviction when God dealt with her. We had two men who we had prayed for who held out an entire year before getting saved. Definitely some miraculous events helping bring them to God were seen. We had a great year in Bible College, we had many of the Christian School students get saved as well. God has been so good.

For the holidays we were able to take some much needed family time to retreat and regroup. We were also able to minister to a few other missionaries who came to Pangia to celebrate with us. It was good for us, as well, to get some of that fellowship in. We had a major need met, and we were able to purchase a brand new generator for the station. It was amazing the timing that went into that supply and purchase. Yet again, God was showing us that He is in control and we don't have to fret about it.

Justin had to take an unplanned trip with Madilenne back to the USA. She is fine, and healthy, but some of her emergency tests are not. Because being without those tests puts Madi in a situation where we won't be able to help her like we had planned, Justin decided to go back within a few days of this discovery. He will be in Western New York taking care of this until January 21. Kayleigh and the other girls are back home in Pangia helping the Wells with prep work for our upcoming ministries.

We will be putting on our first **Youth Camp** of the year the last Monday of

few lost kids to be there. We are hoping to
preach the Gospel to them, and to help them
understand their need of Salvation. This will
go hand in hand with what our church has
been learning about the need to carry the
Gospel. We are hoping that they get good
experience at the altar counseling people
with their Bibles.

We will be starting up the **Bible College** Year 2 in the end of February, and we are looking forward to doing some extra translating and prep work to write some elective classes that we will also use with our pastors in their fellowship meetings. This will help us to bring some structure to their monthly fellowship and will also help us to offer some extra classes in this curriculum that we are preparing for distribution in PNG.

February, when the Bible school students come back, is when we should be **building the clinic**, and March - May is when we plan to be able to finally get Lama and Kumiane their church buildings. It's going to be a lot of work, but we are excited for it!

February also starts a steady stream of visitors from the States, for us and the Wells. We are excited for the opportunity to visit with family, as well as those coming to preach and teach or minister medically. If you are interesting in going on a missions trip, consider visiting us!
