Thank you to all who prayed for our Youth Camp in January! We had nearly 400 people come from several of our churches in the surrounding area. We used a medical theme and focused on when Jesus healed people and had compassion on them. We used Mark 2:17 as our theme verse, and God worked! We had many respond to the preaching and we had 45 kids get saved at this camp! We are still quite excited about how this camp turned out. Some of the pastors gave came to our recent pastor's fellowship and gave testimonies about how God used this camp to help the kids in their churches as well. What an honor to be able to have a part in this work!

We kicked off the 1st semester of Year 2 in our Bible College in February. We have several new enrollments this semester, and we now have about 40 students attending. We have also outlined some elective classes to add to the curriculum. We are intending to get a 3 year course complete with main classes, electives, and tests and quizzes all in Tok Pisin. We will be able to produce books on our printing presses and supply any pastors willing to teach this or start their own college with this curriculum. It has the potential to affect the country in a great way in the coming years!



We are restarting our youth group on Wednesday nights. We are excited to get this rolling again! We take a break through the school "summer" break as most of the kids move around the area and our attendance suffers. We love Soldiers for Christ because of how many kids seem to be helped, affected, and come to know Christ through it. Please pray as we witness to new kids who need to get saved, and as we work with our young believers to help them to grow in Christ!

We had a lady from our church take several hundred tracts back to her village while she took care of her father over the holidays. She was out for 3 months, but she came back with an awesome testimony. She said that in the time that she was back home, she was able to witness to many, and 9 people got saved! Her village in between 3 of our established churches. Please pray for these new converts that they would join to a body of believers and grow.

Please pray for our church as we have been teaching them how to witness to the lost. They seem to be getting it and getting excited. Pray that God gives them opportunities to witness, that they would have the courage and compassion to take them, and that people would get saved!

We continue forward with several construction projects this year. As we have said, we are breaking ground and pouring the foundation of the clinic this month. This will be a great step forward. The church building in Kumiane will follow soon as well. Things are getting exciting and busy, and we love it!
