Greetings,

Thanks for praying over our past prayer letter! We've broken ground on our church building and we've cleared land for the clinic on our mission station. We will be continuing to get these structures up. As a team, there are several other building projects going at the same time. The mission station will look so different by the end of this year. Please keep praying that these projects move forward.

As we started on the foundation in Kumiane, we saw an uptick in spiritual opposition. One good thing is that this pressure has been felt by our people as well. It is sobering for them to realize that there's a fight, but it has given us great opportunities to teach them through these times. We have found it true that when things are going great physically, there can be strong spiritual opposition. On the other hand, sometimes when you're sick and doing poorly physically, you will see some amazing victories on the spiritual side. It's good for our people to learn this as well!

We had our 2nd (hopefully) annual marriage conference back in March. We had around 25 couples come; some were newly married and some were elderly couples. We were able to give preaching and teaching to try to help them break down their cultural ideas that hinders christian principles in our marriages. Praise the Lord, we had one elderly man get saved! His granddaughter had been praying for him for over a year to get saved, and she had been witnessing to him as well. It was awesome to see his conversion!

We had two kids get saved in Soldiers for Christ last month. One is a boy that we've worked with since 2019. His dad is in prison and has been since he was a toddler. His sister got saved in 2019 and is active in our church. They both come from a very catholic family. As you can imagine, we were overjoyed that he finally got saved. The other was a younger boy who was clearly under conviction. He didn't respond in the invitation, and after we dismissed he came to ask me to help him get saved!

It was Justin's privilege to preach just yesterday in our christian school chapel service. During a message on our responsibility to soul win, one of our kids who's family attends our church in Kumiane responded and asked one of his teachers to help him get saved. We've seen such big changes in his family. His dad got saved out a life or drunkenness last year, his mom was saved in 2019, and his life has changed so much in the last year. We try to show our people that when they live how God wants them to, they will see these kinds of changes come in their families!

Please be in prayer for our youth camp that is coming up in the school break in June. We had to postpone it. We had planned on putting on a camp for church kids during the Resurrection Sunday break, but so much happened leading up to camp that we had to move it. We believe that God was directing us to this time, and we are trusting that He will do a great work in the hearts of these kids. Please pray that they will give themselves to the Lord for his service, and that God would call preachers during the camp.
