## Greetings,

What a time the last few months have been! We definitely need the prayers of the saints as we work here. Much of our plans for May went down the tubes when a drunk police officer hit Chad and Kirsten Wells as they drove into town. I was able to run from where I was to get them and take them 2 hours to the hospital. Thankfully they survived, but the car did not. They are still healing up, and we've had to help shoulder some of that workload they normally carry. We thank God that we are here and yoked up with them so that we can help in this way. Please pray for them as they are still healing, still fighting legal battles over the accident, and as they are itching to get back in the saddle!

We were able to host a medical team from the States. It was awesome. They came and were able to run 7 days worth of clinics with us. We required our pastors to facilitate soul winning counselors for these clinics. That's something that has been lacking in our churches; this style of confrontational soul winning. Most of the pastors did awesome and taught their people to at least try. We had some who can't even read and write give the gospel out and see people saved because of their efforts! At the end we saw over 815 people. Each of those got a personal gospel presentation and out of those we had 64 pray to be saved. We were so happy with the fruit from this outreach. We had people who had medicine in hand stay and wait for a soul winner to deal with them . We are just thankful to God for what he did with our churches, pastors, the visiting team, and for us. He is awesome!

Last month Justin preached and taught several times on personal evangelism. He asked our church in Kumiane to let God lay someone on your heart and to start to pray for that person's salvation. The church responded well and has begun praying. Already we know some of their prayers have been answered as parents prayed for their lost children and have started to share scripture with them in the mornings. Justin had been praying for one boy from our church in particular. He sat under preaching and in our christian school for two years and hadn't gotten saved. Last Sunday, he gave a testimony in church and explained that his dad was doing family devotions and he asked his dad to help him pray to get saved. We are so full of happiness to see multiple avenues that we've tried to train our people in come together to help people get saved. Soul winning, prayer and family devotions all played a part. We saw this boys little sister, who is also in our school, get saved during the clinic while Justin had one of our new soul winners "practice" giving the gospel to her. God is moving and we are so excited to be a part of it.

We had some of our contruction stuff get halted and reprioritized with the Wells being banged up. Please pray for the Kumiane church building and the clinic. We still need to work on them.

Also please pray for camp. We will be having camp this first week of July. Pray that souls get saved, and that God gets a hold of our young people. We are looking for Him to call our teens into service for Him!
