We have been blessed quite a bit over the last few months. Chad and Kirsten had a group from a church in Texas come to visit, and they were able to construct a new two story building for our Christian School on the mission station. This classroom will be of great help and benefit as we move forward and continue to grow our teaching ministries on the mission station. This building was also phase I of a larger project to build a multipurpose facility capable of hosting larger camps and meetings.

Our camp at the start of July was a great success! We had about 70 kids come. We decided to try to counsel our kids at the altar and use decision cards with them. This is definitely new to our kids in Pangia, but it is something that Kayleigh and Justin both grew up with at our youth camps. We believe God used this counseling method as we had about 70 decisions at the end of the week. This enabled us to follow up and to pray for our kids as God grows them. We had 5 kids either get saved or come for assurance of salvation counseling. Thanks for praying for this endeavor.

Please be in prayer for our 2nd annual missions conference which will be on Oct 18-20. We will be having Ken Seremak come preach to our people as we prepare to commit to another year of Faith Promise Missions giving. Our church has faithfully supported 3 Papua New Guinean missionaries for this year and they are excited to see what God will do with them this coming year!

- Construction on the Kumiane Church Building (foundation to be poured on September 18!) and our Clinic (construction was started but had to be postponed when the cement mixer broke. Will be resumed soon).
  - Our church members to stay strong during testing and trials; the baptism service.

We've had several children in the church get saved in the past few months. Some had gotten saved at the Pangia Baptist Missionary School chapel class, but we've had a lot of kids, 7 years old or younger, get saved at home with their parents. Most of the testimonies from the parents have shown that they are leading their families in morning devotion time. We have also invested much time over the last few months in preparing to be able to share the Gospel with others. This commitment to teach the Word in the home coupled with our people preparing for giving the Gospel has resulted in these young kid's lives being changed forever! We are so happy as we observe our people taking the lessons from Sunday school and preaching back home and instituting Godly practices in their lives. Oh what God can do as we trust His word. This fruit is encouraging, but please pray for these believers. As they obey the Lord, they're finding out more and more the testing that comes to Christians as they grow. Pray that they will remain strong in their fervor for the Lord despite the increased opposition.

We will be having a baptism service in the coming weeks for these new young converts. Please pray that the service will be a good testimony to the lost, and that these kids will understand the picture that they are partaking in!

Last, we are so happy to be able to host Kayleigh's dad, mom, and sister in the month of September. It's a special time for us to be able to visit with our familiy, and it's a much needed rest for us all!
