Greetings,

Thank you for praying with us for our recent endeavors. We had a great baptism service with 7 of our youths being baptized. One of those is a girl who has been saved for a few years, but has had to stand on her own as her family has fought to get her out of church. She finally proclaimed God's work in her life and was baptized. We are so happy to see her, and others, growing in their faith!

We were able to get the cement foundation poured for the church building in Kumiane. The church has raised their money to buy the metal posts, and we will begin to weld this month. They have already purchased all of the roofing, and they are grading the ground inside of the foundation so that it is ready to have a floor poured. As we are writing this, Justin plans to go to town to load up a truck with Chad and bring back all the iron for both our church in Kumiane and Chad's in Lama Sawmill. Our people are so excited to be able to move forward after some of the delays this year.

We had our inaugural family conference this past week. Between our church and Lama, we had about 100 people in attendance. Justin and Chad preached and taught men's classes. Kirsten and Kayleigh taught sessions for the ladies. Melanie Ellis taught sessions for the kids. We had a great response across the families that came. Many of the fathers and mothers are starting to see clearly that the Bible requires us to instruct and love our kids in order to fulfill and enable to work of God. They were testifying on Sunday how God was leading.

This past month we had a lady get saved that we had been praying for and working with for about a year. She and her daughters had been attending church regularly, but she still hadn't responded to an invitation. Her situation is typical for many women we deal with. Her first husband died, her second husband left her and is putting pressure on her to give their child to him. There's a lot of complicated messiness that had been on her mind, and she held off dealing with her salvation. Thankfully, she responded to the Lord, and now she is opening up to us and we are able to help her respond correctly. Please pray for Alice and she grows, and please pray for her daughters to get saved as well. They participate in our kids programs.

Please be in prayer for our Missions Conference still. We had to reschedule it to Nov 15-17 after Bro. Seremak's car was stolen (and returned!).

Please pray for Justin as he will be preaching a revival with Chad the last week of November for a national church planter that is working to establish a church in his home village outside of Mt Hagen. There will be many lost people there and a great opportunity to reach the lost and help this ministry.

We are currently gathering quotes and shipping details to bring in a new Lister engine for the cement mixer. Please pray for us to find the right machine and right shipping so that we can get those things up and running again!
