Greetings,

Thanks for praying for our requests for the last few months. We had our home church donate money so that we could buy a new engine for the cement mixer and have it shipped in to Papua New Guinea from New Zealand. It should be arriving the first week of February or so. We will be so thankful to have that piece of equipment up and running again as we have quite a lot of cement work between Kumiane, the Clinic, Lama Baptist fellowship, and many more projects on our mission station.

Our Missions Conference went great! Bro Kenny Seremak preached for us and our people responded well. We marked an increase in our giving, and beyond that our people are growing their heart for the lost. Last year, we feel like they obeyed their pastor more than they listened to God. However, this year we noticed a much better response on the spiritual side. Last year they sent out almost \$800, and this year they promised \$1045. This is all coming from subsistence farmers in a jungle who are also trying to build their church building! We are so happy to see this growth.

Justin also preached with Chad in Hagen at the end of November. There was preaching for 4 nights, and we were able to see 11 people get saved because of the meeting. We also saw some pretty good responses towards the preaching. We are hoping and praying that Preacher Patrick, who hosted, sees success and growth with his people as they continue to establish that work. They will be adding a satellite ACE Christian School this year in order to reach kids in their community!

Please pray for:

- Construction on the Kumiane Church Building and Clinic. Pray for the cement mixer engine to arrive on time, so we can move forward with these projects.
- Youth Camp, January 21-24. Pray for souls to be saved and lives to be changed.

Youth Camp is upon us! Please be in prayer for our annual outreach camp. We are expecting anywhere from 350-600 kids this year. We are hoping and praying that many kids get saved and are attached to churches around the Wiru valley. We will also be having two men come visit us and help us during this time. Please pray that Micah McCurry and Zach Kinney aren't delayed in flights and the logistics so that they can come and be a help to our camp!

This month marks 5 years that we have served in PNG. We are reflecting on how far God has brought us in seemingly a short time. We came to the field with two kids, Madilene was born, and our lives got much more complicated. We saw God provide for us and help us learn how to take care of her in order to come back to our field. We have watched take that small medical knowledge for Madi, and grow a soul winning care driven first-aid clinic on our station because of it. We can say souls have been saved and lives have been extended because of God growing us. We have seen our people in Kumiane grow spiritually and make strides that are few and far between in our country. We have seen God further efforts of our team on Pangia Baptist Mission Station to grow harmoniously into works and efforts that are affecting other parts of our country. We are so thankful to God for using us, sustaining us, comforting us, and supplying for His work. Thank you as well for sticking with us, and for faithfully supporting and praying for us. We love our work and our people. We wouldn't want it any other way!
