What an awesome last few months! Thank you all for your prayers for us. We have had a few moments where we were in some danger, but God kept us uninjured. God even used a church to supply funds to fix damage that happened to our car. That kind of thing only happens when the people of God are praying and are in touch with us. We can't say how much that means and how often we think of our supporter base that God has given to us.

Youth Camp was awesome. Bro Micah McCurry preached for us and we saw a fantastic response from the group of kids that came. Out of the nearly 350 kids, 53 were counseled individually by our team of pastors, preachers, and men and women from our churches and they got saved! We saw several kids also make decisions to do a better job at getting out the Good News! It was so good to see the Holy Spirit working.

We kicked off another year in the Christian School (Pangia Baptist Missionary School). It took a lot of work getting our new building ready, but because of that work, our school has a record attendance. Please pray that souls would be saved. This is, hands down, the most productive net we cast as far as the Gospel is concerned!

We also started Year 3 of the college courses for Pangia Baptist Bible College. We plan to have a fairly large graduation at the end of this year. Five of the students who will potentially graduate are from the Kumiane church. We are so happy to see them growing and absorbing the Word of God.

Justin was able to get the cement mixer engine from Lae and the cement mixer is up and running! This will help with our church building, the Well's church building and the clinic. We have been welding up trusses for our building in anticipation of all of this coming together. The plan is to have it up and be in it for services by Resurrection Sunday.

As we are closer to building the church house, we just want to thank God for how well our people have grown. These Bible College students in our church have stepped up with excitement in ministry. Loretta and her husband, Kelly, run our kids Sunday School class. Jeffery and his wife Lois have taken on preaching and teaching in the Religious Instruction class in the local primary school. Every week they have 30-40 kids attend to hear the Word preached to them. Simon, the son of the man who gifted the land we are meeting on, and James both have taken charge of our youth program, Soldiers for Christ. It is a Biblical, but very anti-cultural, step to have church members take over ministries with any kind of faithful consistency. We are so happy to have seen them come this far. Please pray for them to be faithful and Christ honoring as they minister every week. Please pray that they will grow enough to keep these things going as we furlough at the end of this year.
