

Hello friends,

The year keeps moving, and we have been moving at breakneck speed! Thanks for the prayers for our men and women in our church. They have taken charge of Religious Instruction Class and Soldiers for Christ. We've even seen a few get saved from it! Please continue to pray for them as they deepen their understanding of the Word and as they maintain a dedicated work ethic towards the spiritual things.

In March we were able to get the trusses and roof up for our church building in Kumiane. The church was so excited to be finished with this first step. We had our first service in the building on Resurrection Sunday! The people are excited as we now have plenty of space to grow!

In April our team hosted the Doucette family as they came to sing for our evangelistic meetings across the country. We were able to partner with 6 other churches and moved from the coast up to the highlands over 13 days. Chad and Justin preached to groups of 600 - 1,000 each night. We conducted market outreaches and got around 115,000 tracts out in each of the cities where we ministered. We took 35 of our Bible College students on the trip to counsel at the altars and help these churches do outreach during the days. At the end of it, we saw 265 people accept Jesus as their Savior! We are all still amazed at how God worked through the singing, outreach, and the preaching. Our students were encouraged and so were the churches that hosted for us. We also had some people from Kumiane saved because of this, and we praise God for that fruit!

The past few weeks, we have been working on building the clinic. Please pray as we continue to work on that. Pray that it will come together and be fit for service for many years to come!

Please be in prayer for our upcoming visitors. We just sent Zechariah Kinney back after his 3 month stay. Pray for him as he seeks God's direction in the ministry. He was a blessing to the team! Justin's parents will be visiting in June, and right after they leave we will be hosting Kayleigh's brother and his wife for a month. Also Anna, the daughter of one of our supporting pastors, will be coming in June. Pray for her and she is seeking God's leading for her life as she finishes up high school. We are so looking forward to all of our visitors. We love familial visits, but we also like to be used of God to help others make it to the ministry. We feel like we are repaying what others have done for us along the way. We often say that we have the best job in the world, and we believe in exposing others to that same work!

Pray for my sister, Breanna Dye, as she also will be coming in the next two months or so. She is finishing her RN certification and wishes to spend the rest of our term with us. Pray that she would clearly discern if she will work with us in the clinic and be a part of the Pangia Ministry Team!
