Hello friends,

Thanks for the prayers for the missions conference in Mt Hagen last month. I believe the church committed to start supporting two preachers in their area that are working with church plants. We were happy to have been able to participate.

Chad has been slowly improving from his Dengue Fever. He doesn't have any symptoms from the fever itself anymore, but he has been fairly weak and has had hardly any stamina. He is slowly building his workload, but he still hasn't been able to participate in all of our weekly ministries like the Bible School, the Christian School, or any of the preaching that we do. Thanks to all who have prayed and asked about him. Please pray that his strength continues to increase as there is so much to be done.

Due to Chad's continued weakness, we are still postponing Youth Camp, but we still are holding out hope that we will be able to put it on soon.

We have been prepping our Christian School kids to be ready for the ACE PNG competition. We will, hopefully, travel down to Lae in two weeks. Please pray for the convention, the students, and safety on the road. Currently there is a washed out section that we can't drive our buses through, and we are hoping it is passable by next week.

Thanks for praying for Breanna, she has integrated well so far. She works every week in the clinic and has jumped into other ministries with us as well. Pray as she learns Tok Pisin.

It is furlough time for the Dye Family! We are planning on traveling back to America after the Christian School graduation, and that should mean we will be with family for Thanksgiving. We will be furloughing for all of 2025. Please pray that we are able to wrap up ministries and projects before we go. We are definitely feeling the pressure as we have so much coming to a close as we also will be preparing our house and vehicle to be left for the year.

We have already had several churches and pastors reach out to set dates for us to come by and to report to them. We will probably begin calling and booking in the New Year, but if you have some dates in mind you can email, text, or whatsapp us, we can ink those dates before we try to fill everything in.

We also would like to give a big "Thank You" to all who pray specifically for Madilenne and her health. We left for PNG again in 2021 with the goal of being able to stay at least 2 years at a time without needing to furlough for medical reasons. Because of your prayers and the Hand of God, we have been able to stay our entire term and furlough at a 4 year interval. As her parents, this has brought comforting peace of mind, and as missionaries we see how God has used all of this in our people and in ourselves. She will probably need some surgeries on this furlough, but God knows, and He has shown himself worthy of trust through it all. Thank you all for faithful prayers and support for us and our ministry here in Papua New Guinea.
