It is nigh time that we will be coming back. We have our tickets booked and we should be stateside on November 22nd! We are just trying to get things closed down, packed up, and lined up before we take off.

We have a few Sundays left with our church before we go. We will be having one last communion Sunday, possibly a baptism Sunday, and then we will have a mumu with the church. If you don't know, a mumu is where they heat stones on a fire and then bury meat and vegetables in layers with those hot stones into the ground to cook. It will be tasty! It will also be an emotional time as they say goodbye to us for the coming year.

Thankfully, God has helped our core of men get ready for this time that we will be out. Much strengthening of families and Biblical teaching has been invested over the past few years, and it looks like the church at Kumiane will be set up for success as we furlough. We thank God for the blessing of having men raised up and who have submitted to discipleship and training. Many of their dear wives have also grown step by step with instruction and edification from Kayleigh. We regret the need to leave them in this gap, but we are excited to see how God will use them in the space left by our departure.

The Wells left a few weeks ahead of us in preparation of the imminent wedding of their son, Derrick. Please pray for them while they're out for this short time as well. They should be back by February 2025 while we furlough.

Thanks for prayer for Breanna and the PMT Clinic. We have been treating many first aid level sicknesses, and we have seen people witnessed to. We have had multiple people come join our services as visitors in Kumiane as a direct result of this ministry. Pray for us to have wisdom in how to grow it and what we could add to increase our capacity to help people and to direct them ultimately to our Saviour!

Please be in prayer for the Pangia Baptist Missionary School's graduation. We will be helping in that event and leaving the same day to board flights. Please pray that Justin would preach exactly and clearly what the Lord wants, and that souls would be saved in this event.

We should be resting in Buffalo, NY for December and part of January at the request of our pastor. Please pray that we would be able to wisely schedule out our meetings. We are planning a year furlough, but it may get extended as we seek to get Madilenne into a few surgeries to correct some things she was born with as a part of her disease. Making all of this fit together is daunting to say the least, but we trust God to direct it all.

We are also looking forward to encouraging the churches in the work of the Gospel, and showing God's work that he has done among the people in Pangia, Papua New Guinea!
