To our fellowlabourers,

It has been an awesome last few months for our family. We were able to report to several churches that we had not seen in nearly a decade. Our last furlough had been during the pandemic and made connecting with everyone difficult. We had a great time with each church while we reported and fellowshipped with people who've cared for our family for many years now!

We have had about a third of the funds come in for our initial purchase of lab equipment. We've had some others interested in helping as well. Please pray that we are able to continue to build the support of our clinic ministry. Any support towards these projects can be sent to our support address, and designate it as "PMT Clinic" so that it arrives in the right place.

We were also able to be in several meetings with my sister, Breanna. She is raising her personal support to be able to come back with us. Please pray that she raises her needs and that she is able to get her visa approved. She will need some more approvals as she nears her departure date, but these are the first steps.

We had to reschedule our surgery consult for Madilenne, so please continue to pray for that. We are just trying to time everything around the travel that we've already set. We are basically booked through to the end of the year, and we don't want to have to miss churches due to appointments.

Lachlann Alasdair Dye was born on April 3rd! We are so excited about our new addition to the family.



As we type this, he is now I month old! He is adjusting well to our family schedule and pace. We took a few weeks to get Kayleigh and Lach some rest and recuperation, but now we are on the road again.

Please pray for Lachlann as he has the same disease that Madilenne has. On one hand, we are already set up to treat him and test him. We can even use the same tests that Madi uses without needing to bring extra in for him. On the other hand, we have a second child that could get sick or injured and spiral out of control fairly quickly. Madilenne's doctor has taken him on as well. We will need to allow him to grow some before we can take him back to PNG. We also are getting frequent blood work as we try to establish his maintenance dose that he will live on day to day. We are blessed to be counted worthy by the Lord to care for two children with this disease. We are also relieved that we waited for furlough to have our next child! It was a way easier time than in 2019.

Thank you as always for your prayers for our family and for supporting the things that God has led us to do. There is fruit in your account in heaven.
