Thankfully God made a way for us to be able to be at all of our engagements except for one. Thanks to Pastor Grimaldi for being flexible and understanding with us! Thankfully, we are back on the road in the RV and still in wall to wall meetings. God has been blessing as a few new churches have taken us on for support in the last few weeks.

Justin was able to speak at our mission board conference, speak at a new church, and report to two supporting churches one of the weeks that the RV, Kayleigh, and the kids stayed back in NY. We also went as a family to Commonground Baptist Camp. This is the teen camp that has had such an effect on our lives and we were blessed to be a part, and Justin was able to preach. We thank God for how he worked in that week and we are excited for the future of missions as God worked specifically in hearts about being missionaries and yielding to the will of God.

We have had some more money given towards our purchase of the microscope and the blood analyzer. Please pray that we would get the last \$4,000 as we near the days of setting up our container to ship to PNG. We have also had another church take the clinic ministry on for monthly support.

Lachlann is growing and his blood tests have all been within the right ranges. Pray with us as we are in the next stage of dialing in his daily dose of meds before we leave for PNG.

Madilenne also has another appointment in July to consult with a surgeon for her upcoming procedure. Please pray for wisdom and the right timing of all of this as we have begun to look at ticket prices to go back at the end of the year. We need a few more logistical issues to be handled before returning, but Lord willing, we should have some better idea in the next few months.

Pray for us as we travel. We are moving all around the country at this point, and we need stamina and safety as we minister to the churches that we will be with. We thank God that in almost every meeting thus far, God has given us someone specific to minister to. The churches have all had great responses to preaching, the Word of God, and the moving of the Spirit. We are blessed that God would use us to encourage the saints, and we look forward to the second half of the year.
