Brethren,

Thank you for your prayers for us as we travel the USA and report on this furlough! We have driven nearly the entire breadth of the contiguous states and we are preparing for our longest stretch north to south in the coming days. God has been so good to us, and has sustained us by his saints as we roll on down the road.

Praise the Lord that we have all the funds that we need to purchase the new lab equipment for the clinic. We are putting those orders together now in order to have them in NY waiting when we come off the road in November. We will need some training and practice before packing them for shipping in our container.

Please continue to pray for Madilenne and her surgery date. We would like to get this taken care of before we leave and we need 3 months of recovery and follow up before we can responsibly go back to our field. We should know what date we will be working with in the next few weeks.

Pray with us that we would be able to leave for PNG and be there in January or early February. We have multiple people interested in coming for a visit, and we would love to be set and ready to host. This time of year is already important as we kick off Bible School and the Pangia Baptist Missionary School years. There's much work involved and this all happens as we put a youth camp on for teens as well!

Please pray for:

- Safety on the road and for us to be a blessing to the churches we visit.
- Funds and Support for the Clinic Ministry.
- A surgery date for Madilenne.
- Wisdom & direction for packing and shipping a container.
- Logistics & timing of our return to PNG (we are hoping for Jan or Feb 2026)

Pray for us as we are pricing shipping a container. Please pray for wisdom and direction for the making the right choices as we have never done this before. Ultimately it should be a blessing to be able to send so much at a cost effective rate, however there are quite a few moving parts and regulations to follow in order to do it correctly. We've had people collecting medical equipment and other items for us, so this container is necessary. It will be well worth the few thousand dollars to get it across the ocean and up to Pangia!

The last thing that we are still asking churches to support is the clinic itself. We hope to raise a monthly budget for this ministry so that it remains self sustaining and can grow. If your church is led to support this, please reach out to us and we can supply the details of where to send those funds. Praise the Lord we have a few churches that have taken this ministry on, but pray that we can get a few more to support it!

As we are in our home stretch of reporting to the churches, we can say that it has been a blessed year visiting, reconnecting, and meeting new churches. The people of God across America have been encouraging and a blessing to us. Preaching, words of encouragement, and even some song services have been exactly what we've needed.
