We have finished our full time traveling as we settle in for this surgery and for setting things in order as we prepare to go back to Papua New Guinea. We are moving out of the RV. It has served us quite well over the past year, but it is time to list it for sale. Please pray that we would be able to sell this quickly.

Thank you for praying for the clinic. Since our last letter, we've seen multiple gifts given in support for the clinic. We are making those purchases and getting things set to pack up for shipping to PNG. We are excited about what God will be able to do with these tools and avenues of care being made available to our people. Many things are coming together for this ministry, and we are looking forward to seeing these investments reap eternal dividends.

Please keep praying for us as we are still deciding on how to go about shipping the container. Since we don't ship cargo regularly, it is an interesting process to find a shipper willing to deal with us. Pray that we would make wise decisions and that we would be able to send the container in a timely and efficient manner. Pray as we pack it in the winter months of Buffalo, NY! It is going to be fun!

Madilenne will be having her procedure on November 17th at 7:30am. Please pray that the surgery is successful and heals perfectly. Please pray that she won't lose feeling or bladder control as a result of the surgery. Please pray for us all as we care for her during her recovery. She should be in the hospital for a night or two, and then she will have a week of recovery at home. After 3 months we will be able to have a follow up with her surgeon. This appointment is the last timing goal we have before we can go back to PNG.

The other hurdle that we have to surmount before we can return is our family's visas. They have been in renewal since we have left the country. There are multiple families besides our that are being affected by the same delays. Please pray that we would have favor with the right people, and that Bro Gray, who handles our applications and sponsorship for visas, is able to move things forward. It is never fun to be stuck in limbo with things out of your control, however God knows and will see it through.

One of the blessings of waiting for surgeries and visas is that we will be able to minister to our home church. We will be able to enjoy another holiday season with our families, and we are truly blessed to have this chance once more before a few more years on the field!
