To our supporting churches and prayer partners,

We have a bittersweet ministry update to share with you all. As many of you know, we've been presenting the future plans of our ministry during this furlough. A large piece to that puzzle has been my sister. If you've seen her presentation, you understand that she has been planning to come work in our PMT clinic along side of us. Much of what she's worked towards has been this life decision, from her education and qualification to her presenting this work in churches for support.

When she initially started, she was advised to acknowledge that as a single lady, marrying a man could alter this direction. We knew this was a possibility going into this partnership. Breanna has found a man that she believes the Lord would have her marry. She also acknowledged that she didn't believe that she could serve longer than a short time, perhaps less than a year, in Pangia with us. She, our pastor and ourselves agreed that it would be better to move forward in that relationship. We are happy that she has been directed by the Lord, however we are sad that she will not be able to serve with us.

We will still be moving forward with the PMT clinic. Breanna had certainly boosted our reach and capacity to minister, but even before she arrived, God had proven to us that he wanted us to keep this ministry open. If you've seen our presentation this furlough, you know that since 2021 we have seen about 1500 people on our front porch before we even had a building to administer this first aid care.

In obedience to God, we will continue to do our best to minister to people both physically with the clinic as well as to their souls in preaching the Gospel to them. If you wish to still have a part in supporting the clinic, we would ask you to consider sending support to the clinic directly. This funding would cover purchasing of medicines as well as the many consumable supplies that we use in our treatments. Currently we pay for common medicines out of pocket to keep up our stocks. If you choose to give to the PMT Clinic, this would enable it to be self supporting.

Make checks payable to Word for the World Baptist Ministries, and put on the memo line, "PMT Clinic." If you participate this way, this allows us to keep the funding and record keeping of this ministry separate from our personal funding.

We are still marveling at how supportive many of you have been of Breanna and we love how excited many of you have been about this ministry. We are grateful for the part that you've had thus far, and we hope that some will choose to still help fund this cause.

We believe that we have some of the best supporters in the world, and we can't describe well enough the blessing that you've always been to our family. Thank you for your prayers as we prep to go back and as we deal with this direction change in Pangia, SHP, Papua New Guinea.
