Brethren,

Thank you for your prayers for us in regards to our container and for our visa approvals. As always, God has sustained us in our waiting and has allowed us to be at work for him and his glory.

Our container was picked up this past month. There were some last minute changes with the shipping that delayed it. Many of the shipping companies have had issues and price increases with the different things happening in the Middle East. None of our routes would have taken us through the Strait of Hormuz, however fuel prices globally have increased and our shipper was waiting for prices to be more friendly. Gladly, that tangled mess of logistics and paperwork are now behind us and our container is in transit to PNG. Please continue to pray that things would arrive safely, intact, and everything would clear customs without trouble when it arrives in port.

We've had some small progress on the visa situation. Justin is fully approved to fly to PNG. Unfortunately, Kayleigh's and the children's visas have only now begun their processing. We've been told that there are "thousands" of applications ahead of us. Please pray for favor with the officers that check over our applications and that we would be able to return quickly to PNG. Pray for our sponsor as well. He has come down with Typhoid. We need him to be able to travel to the immigration office to communicate with the officers on our approvals. Pray that he is well soon!

As much as we have desired to be in PNG, God has seen fit to allow us to minister in our home church. Pastor Baran has asked Justin to preach Sunday evening services while we are back, and Kayleigh has been able to grow close to the ladies in our church. The sermons preached and the fellowship amongst the brothers and sisters have been sweet and profitable. Our girls will be attending summer camp, and will hopefully be making good memories and decisions there. We are grateful for the time God has given us. Please pray that we would not be discontent with these circumstances.

We were supposed to be taking part in what the Pangia Ministry Team is now doing. Many outreaches across the country have been taking place. Campaigns for Christ is an outreach with dozens of men and women traveling into PNG to take part in gospel tract and John and Romans distribution. They have been working along rivers on our north coast to preach and distribute materials. Already partway through, we have gotten reports of many getting saved. If you would, pray with us that these efforts are fruitful.

We are praying that our next letter will be sent from PNG. Please pray that we have the right timing and that airline tickets would be priced well for us as we return.

Thank you to each and every one who prays for us as we serve. Your prayers are always a blessing and a help to us. Keep holding the ropes!
