Matthew 6:14, "For if ye forgive m _____ their trespasses, your heavenly Father will also forgive you:"







6. Keeping His commandments.

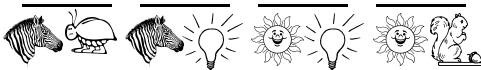

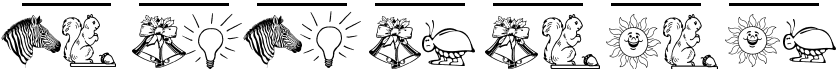

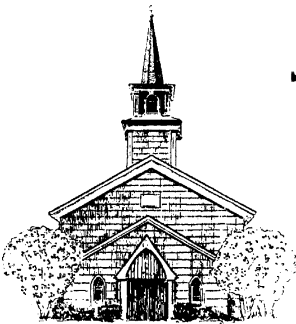
