1. We have to be saved first. Being saved is accepting Jesus as our Saviour - believing He died for our sin and rose again as God only could. Only Christians will be in heaven. Jesus said in *John 14:6, "Jesus saith unto him, I am the w___, the truth, and the life: no m___ cometh unto the Father, but by me."*



2. When we die we are immediately with Christ. *II Corinthians 5:8, "... to be absent from the body, and to be* p_{-} _ _ _ *with the Lord."* There is no mention of a place called purgatory in the Bible; our soul staying in the grave or reincarnation (coming back in the form of animals, people and other creatures). The angels carry our spirit and soul to Christ when we die. Luke 16:22, "And it came to pass, that the beggar died, and was c_{-} _ _ _ by the angels into Abraham's bosom: ..."

3. We will receive a perfect, new, invincible body some day when Jesus



comes to take us (see the "V" booklet). I Corinthians 15:52-53 "In a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trump: for the trumpet shall sound, and the dead shall be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed. For this corruptible must put on incorruption, and this mortal must put on
