### November's Verse:

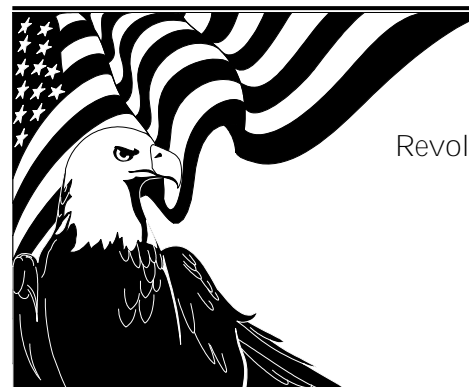
*"But as for me, when they were sick, my clothing was sackcloth; I humbled my soul with fasting; and my prayer returned into mine own bosom."*

Our very special guest speaker today is Bro Burt Kephart. Burt and his wife, Donna, live in Franklin, PA. They have two remaining children, David and Deborah.

**Burt's son, Jonathan, died on April 8, 2004 when his squad of 11 MP's were ambushed after only being in Iraq for 10 days. They were ambushed by approximately 300-500 of the enemy. At anytime 20-50 were firing on them. The ambush lasted 30 minutes. Because of the heroics of Jonathan, firing on the enemy even when wounded, the rest of his squad survived. He gave his life to save theirs. We honor him and all veterans today.**

Burt is also a member of the Faith Baptist Church of Cranberry, PA. He graduated from Fairhaven Bible College of Indiana. We are honored to have Burt with us today.
