## FBBC Church History

The Faith Bible Baptist Church was started by our Lord on Sunday, March 13, 1983. It's charter members were: Ed and Carol Durham, Mark and Craig Durham, Bob and Lori Rizzo, Jeff and Julie Haenel, and Pastor and Mrs. Kohl. Their children also attended the first service. There were fourteen people in attendance.

For three months the church met in Ed and Carol Durham's home in Angola, New York. It soon became apparent that more room was needed. One Sunday, thirty-eight people crowded into the house.

Faith Bible Baptist soon moved to a storefront building at 25 North Main Street in Angola. A bus ministry was started, and two buses began to bring people in for the services.

An adjacent storefront was rented; then another; and at one point, a bus parked in the back parking lot served as a classroom.

The church stayed in this location for two years. A high attendance of 191 was enjoyed there; 104 people attended the first anniversary.

Miraculously, the Lord opened a door for Faith Bible Baptist to move to an unused school building in Farnham. We stayed in the school building for four years without paying a penny for rent, and for this we are indebted to the family of Ralph Hogg, Sr.

Many people were saved there. The highest Sunday attendance was 278 people, but a week of Revival meetings in 1988 averaged over 300 people in attendance over five nights.

The Church moved to its present location on May 1, 1989. By the closing date of November 30 that same year, the building was paid for in cash.

In 1996 the men of the Church built a 1200-square-foot addition to the south side of the building. This added space supplied more seating in the auditorium upstairs and room for a printing ministry in the basement.

In 2002 Faith Bible Baptist added another 1200-foot addition, this time to the north side of the building. This space provided more auditorium seating, four classrooms, and bathrooms downstairs. Both these additions were also paid for in cash. Amazingly, three large monetary gifts from women paid for most of the supplies needed for these 2 additions.

The Church has averaged over 250 people each Sunday during the 19 years we have been in Eden. There have been more than 35 Sundays with 300 or more in attendance.

Only the Lord knows how many souls have been saved over the years through the people and ministries of the Church.

May the Lord bless all who had a part.

Next Sunday morning we will begin our new time schedule for assembling:


- 9:00 AM - Prayer Meetings and Music Practices
