8 Commandments for Children Regarding Mothers

In order as they appear in the Bible

1. Honor Your Mother. Exodus 20:12 *"Honour thy father and thy mother: that thy days may be long upon the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee."*
2. Never Hit Your Mother. Exodus 21:15 *"And he that smiteth his father, or his mother, shall be surely put to death."*
3. Never Curse your Mother. Exodus 21:17 *"And he that curseth his father, or his mother, shall surely be put to death."*
4. Never Uncover her Nakedness. Leviticus 18:7 *"The nakedness of thy father, or the nakedness of thy mother, shalt thou not uncover: she is thy mother; thou shalt not uncover her nakedness."*
5. Fear Your Mother. Leviticus 19:3a *"Ye shall fear every man his mother, and his father,"*
6. Obey Your Mother. Deuteronomy 21:18-21 *"If a man have a stubborn and rebellious son, which will not obey the voice of his father, or the voice of his mother, and that, when they have chastened him, will not hearken unto them: Then shall his father and his mother lay hold on him, and bring him out unto the elders of his city, and unto the gate of his place; And they shall say unto the elders of his city, This our son is stubborn and rebellious, he will not obey our voice; he is a glutton, and a drunkard. And all the men of his city shall stone him with stones, that he die: so shalt thou put evil away from among you; and all Israel shall hear, and fear."*
7. Never Lightly Esteem Your Mother. Deuteronomy 27:16 *"Cursed be he that setteth light by his father or his mother. And all the people shall say, Amen."*
8. Never Rob Your Mother. Proverbs 28:24 *"Whoso robbeth his father or his mother, and saith, It is no transgression; the same is the companion of a destroyer."*
