Gary lived in the Mockeries River Delta of the Canadian Arctic for over 20 years. He is an arctic bush pilot. He lived and traveled with the native people of the region. He has logged thousands of miles by snowmobile and slept often in tent with temperatures down to -40 degrees.

Gary has killed over 100 caribou for food and has taken 8 moose, 1 Dall's sheep, 2 black bear (1 with a bow & 1 with flintlock), many whitetail deer, those adventures with us. 18 turkeys, and numerous small game and birds.
