How much has the Iraq War Cost each American  
in Dollars & Cents?

Do the math:

Total Spent - \$648 Billion dollars

**That's \$2,090 per American (There are 30 million Americans)**

Now, the war has gone on for 2,037 days, or 5 years + 7 months.

Total Cost: \$1.03 per American, per day.
