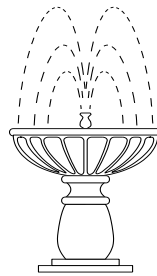

Many years ago when D.L. Moody was still busy in this country, there was an industrial exposition in Chicago. There was in the exposition ground a fountain which became the rendezvous for folk who arranged to meet each other. One would say to another, "Will you meet me at the fountain?" The answer was, "All right, I'll meet you at the fountain."

P.P. Bliss, the gospel song writer, was allured with this meeting place. He wrote the gospel song based on it, lifting the thought from the meeting place in the exposition ground to that higher meeting place, and he wrote this:

"Will you meet me at the fountain,
When I reach the glory land?
When you meet me at the fountain,
Shall I clasp your friendly hand?
Other friends will give you welcome;
Other loving voices cheer;
