Jesus' enemies' chief ambition was not to remove the body, but keep it in the tomb, hence their application to Pilate for the guard to be set at the tomb. Had they removed the body, they would have produced it and confused the disciples as soon as they preached Jesus' resurrection. Yet the apostles were allowed to preach it within a few yards of the empty tomb.

The Stone In Front of the Tomb

The stone that was rolled from the tomb was a wheel of granite, eight feet in diameter and one foot thick. Rolled into a groove, it would weigh more than 4 tons.

Garden Tomb's Soil Analyzed

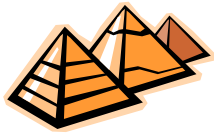
When the Garden Tomb was discovered in 1885, the godly General Gordon was convinced that this was the place where the body of Jesus had lain. There is a traditional tomb inside the wall of modern Jerusalem, but no certainty attaches to this site.

The Garden Tomb, hidden for centuries, was covered with rubbish twenty feet high. When they first cleared the spot, with great caution they gathered all the dust and debris within the tomb and carefully shipped it to the Scientific Association of Great Britain. Every part of it was analyzed, but there was no trace of human remains. If this is the real tomb of Christ, then Jesus was the first to be laid there and he was also the last.
