\* **Pastor's Note:** The NIV has 66,000 less words than the KJB and the NKJV has 20,000 less words than the KJB. With that in mind, consider these verses:

Proverbs 30:5 *"Every word of God is pure: he is a shield unto them that put their trust in him."*

Deuteronomy 4:2 *"Ye shall not add unto the word which I command you, neither shall ye diminish ought from it, that ye may keep the commandments of the LORD your God which I command you."*

Deuteronomy 12:32 *"What thing soever I command you, observe to do it: thou shalt not add thereto, nor diminish from it."*

Revelation 22:19 *"And if any man shall take away from the words of the book of this prophecy, God shall take away his part out of the book of life, and out of the holy city, and from the things which are written in this book."*

Matthew 24:35 *"Heaven and earth shall pass away, but my words shall not pass away."*

The NIV contains only 91% of the KJB. Now they are coming out with a new one in 2011. Don't be fooled, and don't buy it.
