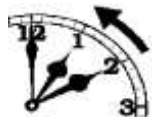
21, Saturday - Wedding of Josh Maulucci & Lisa Broughton at 10:30 am. All welcome to observe the ceremony.

*He Cooked His Own Meals*

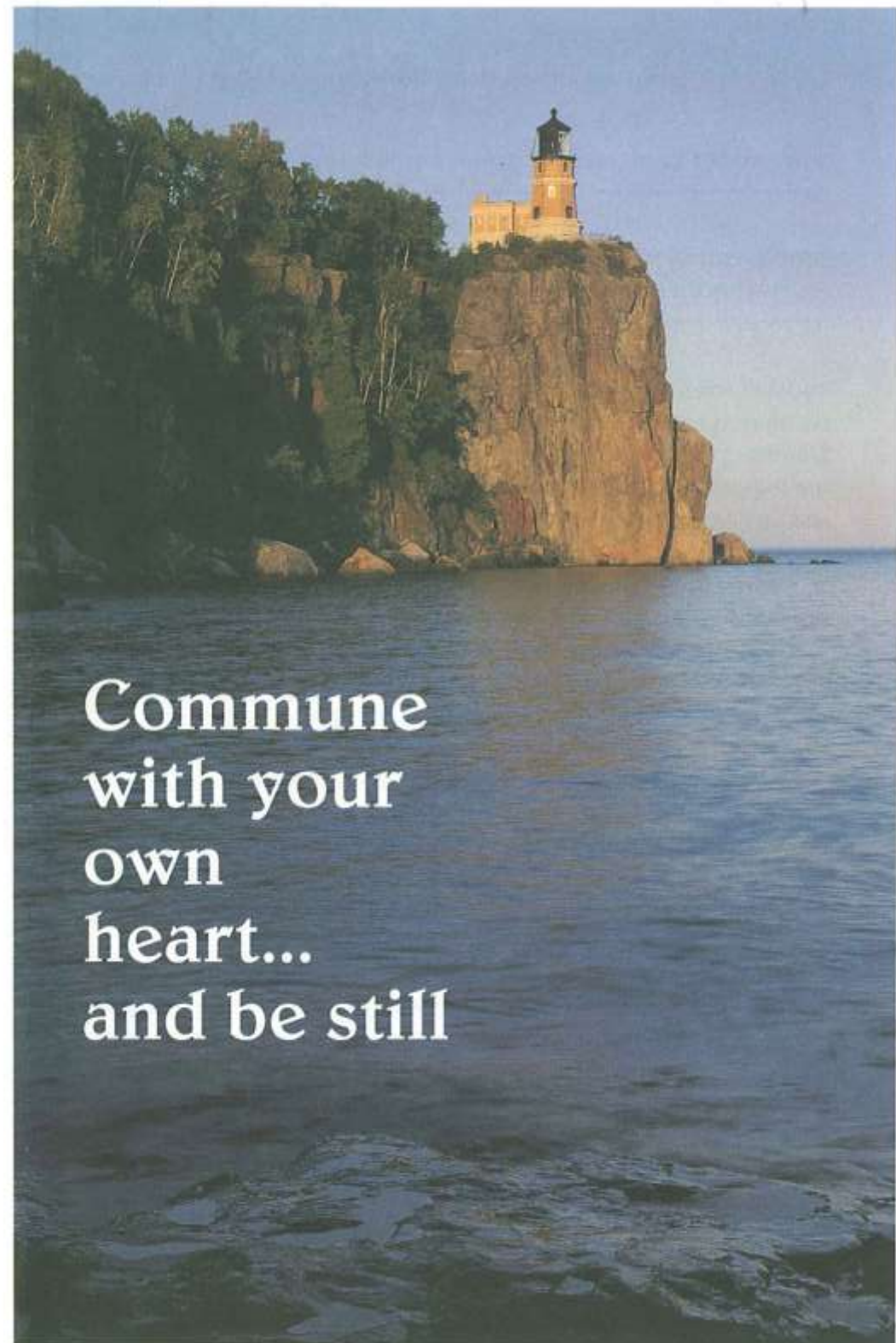
