Text: Colossians 1:10

1. **Be involved in Children’s Ministries & Evangelism** by participation or prayer. Matthew 18:14

3. Be a good testimony. Be stable in your behavior, speech, dress, example and words.
4. Work in the love of God and in the power of the Holy Ghost.
